All projects must be delivered and assembled on the afternoon of March 15th. The Exploratory and First Year Career and Technical Showcase and the Team Engineering Challenge are the only events that middle school students are eligible to compete.
2. The Spring Leadership Conference will be Friday, March 10th at New England Tech.'s East Greenwich Campus.

Their production should include concept art and/or storyboards, the sample or prototype itself, an executive overview of the project, and a printed résumé for each team member. Résumés should include the industry experience gained from developing the contest submission, time invested, and the professional and academic relevance to the contestant's career ambitions.
